ORDINANCE # 9

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ESTABLISHMENT OR USE OF MOVABLE STRUCTURES FOR RESIDENTIAL OR BUSINESS PURPOSES IN WEST PIKE-LAND TOWNSHIP AND PRESCRIBING FINES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Section 1. The establishment or use of movable structures, such as those commonly used for trailer camps, for residential or business purposes is prohibited in this Township except while in transit and then only for not more than six hours.

Section 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense, and each day that the violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 1. The establish~~ment~~ or use of mov~~able~~ structures, such as those commonly used for trailer camps, for residential or business purposes is prohibited in th~~s~~ Township except while in transit and then only for not more than six hours; provided, that in cases of emergency, mechanical or otherwise, such movalbe structures may remain within the Town-ship for a reasonable period of time until such emergency shall no longer compel the use of such movable structure within the Township; and, provided further that movable structures commonly used by building contractors may remain on building sites actual~~ly~~ in construction progress until substantial completion of such construction.

Section 2. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense, and each day that the violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
