
An Ordinance of the Township of West Pikeland, Chester County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania under authority of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code Establishing Additional Stop Signs at the Pine Creek Bridge

The Board of Supervisors of West Pikeland Township does hereby enact and ordain as follows:


- Section 1.** This Ordinance amends Ordinance 2000-3 adopted April 3, 2000, as it authorizes the installation and enforcement of additional Stop Signs on either side of the Bridge on the driveway entering and exiting Pine Creek Park. All other Stop Signs identified under Ordinance 2000-3, or any other Township Ordinances designating stop signs, shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 2.** Either side of the Bridge on the driveway entering or exiting Pine Creek Park are established as stop thoroughfares and the installation and enforcement of official Stop Signs in such position as to face traffic in either direction or directions hereby indicated is authorized.
- Section 3.** If any part of this Ordinance is declared invalid, such declaration shall not affect the remainder.
- Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment.






