APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA

Supervisor Holling motioned to add the purchase of a computer for the new Township Manager.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Chair, Bright opened the floor for addition or corrections to the minutes of March 21, 2016. Hearing none, the Chair approved as submitted.

PERSONS WISHING TO BE HEARD

The Chair asked if any one wished to present issues not on the agenda. No one present wished to be heard.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- a. Supervisor, Holling moved to approve final land development plans for ACMEC. Chair, Bright Seconded, all voted Aye.
- b. Chair, Bright opened a public hearing regarding changes to the proposed street numbering ordinance. Public hearing on the issue was adjourned until May 2nd.
- c. Supervisor, Holling motioned to ratify terms of employment of new Township Manager, Jim Wendelgass. Chair, Bright seconded, all voted, Aye.
- d. Discussion of Barn demolition was held. It was decided, at this time, the Township would not demolish the barn at Pine Creek Park. Additional bids for demolishing the barn at the White Property will be obtained. Question was posed and discussion followed on the subject of filling wells at the White property.
- e. Municipal space planning and cost estimating. Approved Vince checking with the two free

providers. Vince Visoskas was approved to pursue these granted same specifications provided to Kimmel-Bogrette Architecture.

- d. A discussion was held regarding a zoning issue in Twin Hills. The attorney for Twin Hills offered to draft the ordinance amendment for review by Township solicitor and then forwarding to planning commission for action.
- e. Chair, Bright motioned to approve Township Secretary, Jonathan Slaven, to be the signing agent for PEMA documents in order to receive funds from Winter Storm Jonas. Supervisor Holling seconded, all voted Aye.
- f. Supervisor, Hallman motioned to approve the Historic Commission's recommendation to approve projects at 750 Upper Pine Creek and 1441 Horseshoe Trail. Supervisor, Holling seconded, all voted Aye.
- g. Supervisor, Holling motioned to approve funds for purchase of new computer for Township Manager. Chair, Bright seconded, all voted Aye.
