**APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA**

The agenda was accepted as presented.

**APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES**

Chairman Bright opened the floor for additions or corrections to the minutes of May 2, 2016. Hearing none, the Chairman approved the minutes as submitted.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

- a. Approval of Bills. Supervisor Holling made a motion to approve the bills as submitted. It was seconded by Chairman Bright. The motion was approved unanimously
- b. Consideration of hiring of Chris Maguire for seasonal assistance to the Public Works Department. Motion to approve at the same rate as late year by Supervisor Holling. Seconded by Chairman Bright. After a short discussion it was approved unanimously.
- c. Lionville Special Fire Police Officer Appointments. Lionville Fire Department submitted a list of candidates for the Board's approval. Supervisor Holling made a motion to approve the list as presented. It was seconded by Supervisor Hallman. Supervisor Hallman asked whether the candidates had been through training. Chief Clark responded that all the candidates had been through certification training. The motion was approved unanimously.
- d. Discussion of the barn demolition project on the White Property. The consultant working on the park project for this parcel has obtained a proposal from Glen Miller Demolition and Excavating Inc. to demolish the barn for \$16,500.00. Supervisor Holling made a motion that the consultant attempt to obtain two more bids and that the Board hereby approves the lowest bid at a cost not to exceed the current bid of \$16,500.00. Supervisor Conti seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously.
- e. Discussion of Eagle Farms Road. Two Supervisors had recently met with residents of the Twin Hills subdivision to discuss their concerns over the use of Eagle Farms Road and West Vincent Township's decision to close a portion of South Chester Springs Road. After a discussion of the problems and potential solutions, Supervisor Holling proposed that the Township join with two neighboring townships and the various state legislators representing the residents in those townships and approach Penn Dot to ask for its assistance in dealing with the traffic issues between Fellowship Road in Upper Uwchlan and Byers Road in West Pikeland Township.
